Call for President of Global Century Press

Global China Academy (GCA) invites applications for the position of President of Global Century Press (GCP), its publishing arm founded in 2014. GCP publishes academic works and related publications in the social sciences and humanities, with a focus on China from global and comparative perspectives and Chinese-English dual-language publishing.

Main Responsibilities

The President will provide strategic leadership and institutional representation for GCP, working closely with the GCA President, Editor-in-Chief and publishing team. Responsibilities include:

- contributing to GCP's long-term strategy and development;
- supporting books, journals and other publishing programmes;
- developing relationships with authors, editors, academic institutions and publishing partners;
- representing GCP externally and strengthening its international collaboration and academic impact;
- advancing major publishing initiatives and institutional partnerships.

Person Specification

We are looking for someone who:

- supports the academic and social missions of GCA and GCP;
- has substantial experience in academic publishing, higher education, research, cultural communication or a related field;
- has strong organisational and communication skills, sound judgement and institutional responsibility;
- has an international outlook and experience of working across institutions and cultures;
- can contribute to the role on a continuing basis.

Experience in academic publishing, editorial work, international collaboration, dual-language publishing or institutional development is particularly welcome.

Nature of the Role

This is a senior voluntary role carrying significant institutional responsibility and representation. The President will focus on strategic development, institutional coordination and external representation rather than day-to-day editorial and production work.

The appointment will be confirmed at the appropriate level of GCA governance.

Application

Applicants should complete the relevant GCA application form and provide:

- a CV;
- a short statement on their relevant experience and reasons for applying;
- a brief statement on their vision for GCP and the contribution they could make.
